CREDANT Compliance Reporter provides today's organizations with the extensive visibility they need into encryption status, policy deployment, and other compliance details related to endpoints and users. Reports can be run on demand or scheduled for later execution with results automatically emailed to stakeholders. Report results can also be displayed and manipulated from within the Compliance Reporter interface or exported for use in third-party applications.

With CREDANT Compliance Reporter, organizations can gain a comprehensive, accurate and real-time overview of data protection for their endpoints – backed by a wide range of reporting to address regulatory requirements and industry standards.

FLEXIBLE, BROWSER-BASED SOLUTION

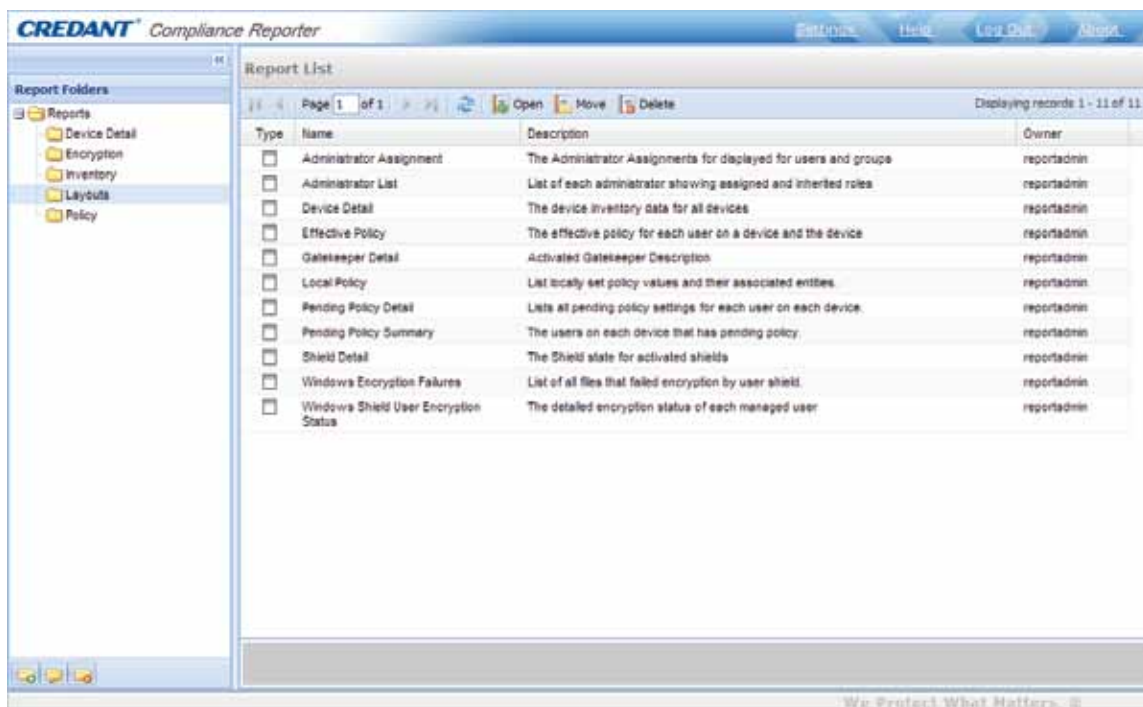
Accessible through any supported web browser, CREDANT Compliance Reporter provides a variety of web-based reports

for policy management, encryption status, device inventory, and administrator roles for CREDANT Mobile Guardian 5.3 and later environments. Report views can be customized by changing data field inclusion, sorting, grouping, column order, and filtering on result set contents.

In addition, administrators can schedule report execution according to their needs and email results to stakeholders. They can also monitor deployments by scheduling report execution at specific intervals to see how the organization's compliance status has changed over time.

MULTI-LEVEL ADMINISTRATIVE AND ACCESS CONTROL

Three administrator roles provide fine-grained permission management. The Report Administrator provides full access to the Reporter administrative options. Report Owner enables administrators to customize, save, and schedule reports. If administrators want to run only pre-existing reports, Report User is available.



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An IT administrator can easily monitor device encryption or policy deployment status across users, devices, groups, domains, or the entire environment. Information can be easily queried to determine the state of a device that is lost or stolen so the appropriate response can be made quickly and confidently.

Reports can be easily shared, although access can also be restricted according to user. In addition, the Compliance Reporter can off-load any resource intensive reporting operations to machines other than the CREDANT Mobile Guardian Server host, yet still provide ease of access to multiple administrative users with a single management console.

REPORTING FOR SARBANES-OXLEY REQUIREMENTS

CREDANT Compliance Reporter provides an in-depth view of all administrative users and groups and their permissions. This is especially useful for producing Sarbanes-Oxley reports that require a list of all administrative users and their permissions, regardless of whether the permissions were assigned directly to them or if they were inherited from group memberships. Administrators can also see which groups were assigned permissions that other users have inherited.

EASY INTEGRATION AND EXPORTING

New reports and functionality can be easily imported into existing CREDANT Compliance Reporter installations. This allows for customization beyond what is available with saving report views. Each report "layout" that is available for configured and saved report views is a separate "plug-in" into the system. New plug-ins can be created and installed on an existing CREDANT Compliance Reporter installation without requiring a full Compliance Reporter upgrade.

CREDANT Compliance Reporter also provides the ability to export reports for use in third-party applications. With a single click, users can export report data for use with Crystal Reports[®], Microsoft[®] Excel[®], or other third-party applications. Therefore, CREDANT Compliance Reporter delivers a solid baseline for data presentation, while also supporting the ability to leverage other tools for more advanced analysis.
